- The Board discussed the Virginia Board of Barber and Cosmetology's *new* State Examination and whether the Board will accept, Virginia licenses who apply for a DC license by endorsement. The Board indicated that the NIC was the prevailing examination that it currently uses. However, if NIC accepts Virginia's examination as comparable, the Board agreed to revisit the issue.

Agenda Item: OLD BUSINESS

2014 Practitioners Forum

The Board Chair discussed and provided a recap of the 2014 Practitioners Forum that was held in June. All members agreed that the event was successful. The Board Administrator also indicated that licensees who attended the Forum responded positively – completing the Forum Survey that was emailed. Members also noted that again this year, as with Forums in the past, the venue is too small to accommodate the DC practitioners seeking to obtain continuing education credits. The Board recommended a larger location, and suggested submitting a proposal to the DC City Council for consideration to change sites. The Board also reviewed past practices regarding vendors, suggesting that more vendors could appear at the Forum.

Board members will individually update Chart with Chapter 37 Municipal Regulations; at next several meetings, and provide a final draft with Board's recommendations, changes, edits to Board's Legal Advisor, Kia Winston.

The Board will continue its work to revise and update the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, Chapter 37, Barber and Cosmetology. Board Chair Derek Davis also appointed members to the Body Art Committee. The Committee members are Paul Roe, Body Artist, Committee Chair, Eric Doyle, Body Artist Member, and Tammy R. Musselwhite, Consumer Member. These members will create and write the DC Board Body Art regulations, which licenses "individual practitioners." The Committee also plans to collaborate with the Department of Health (DOH) regarding their *proposed* Body Art regulations regarding "establishments."
